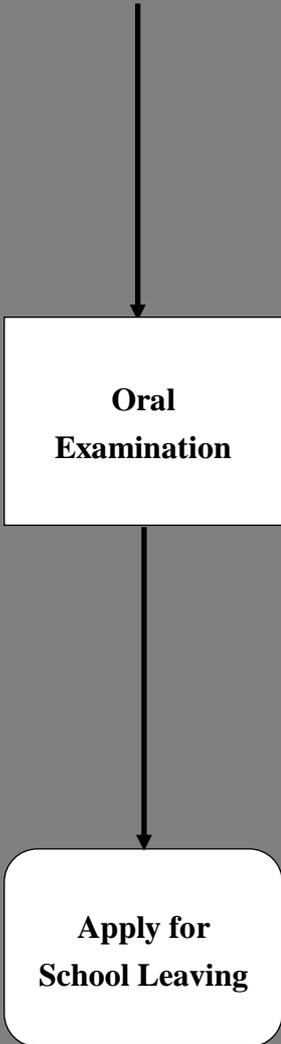

Prerequisite courses: Students are required to pass two of the four subjects (Data Structures, Algorithms, Operating System, Computer Organization and Structure) ※Application Form for Course Exemption: Department of Computer Science website /Download /Application Form – Master Student/ Application Form for Course Exemption 2. Credit Exemption: The credit exemption limit is 9 credits. ※Application Form for Credit Exemption: Academic Affairs Office Registration Section Website/

Portal / NCCU Information System / Student Information System/ Academics/ Graduate Student Degree Thesis Title Declaration to apply for a declaration and ask the advisor to sign the document. 2. The alteration of the thesis advisor shall be approved by the new advisor, the original advisor, and the department council. 3. After changing the thesis advisor, the research paper plan should be resubmitted, and the plan should be approved by the new advisor, the original advisor, and the department council.

	<p>Students who don't request deferred graduation should apply to leave school within one month after the end of the semester in which the degree examination is held (Mar. 1st of the first semester and Sep. 1st of the second semester).</p>	<p>1. Portal / NCCU Information System / Student Information System/ Academics/ Graduation Procedure Checklist As indicated in the school leaving procedure sheet, complete the inspection of the department, library, secretariat, Life Guidance & Overseas Chinese Student Advising section, and office of International Cooperation.</p> <p>2. A hardback or paperback copy of the master's thesis should be submitted to the department for record upon graduation.</p> <p>3. Once complete the school leaving process, students can bring the student ID card to the Registration Section to receive the degree certificate.</p>

Credit Requirement Principle for Master Students

* * Credit requirements for each division are shown as below:

A- Division of Information Science and Engineering, Division of Intelligent Computing

B- Cross-divisional Students in the Information Science and Engineering Division

C- For Students with additional quota, the division (A or B) will be confirmed by the admission section before entrance, and may have one chance to apply for a change of division.

* * Prerequisite Courses Requirements

1. Freshmen who have graduated from the department of Information Engineering, the department of Computer Science, or who have passed the entrance examination of the Master's program of the department will be deemed to have passed the prerequisite courses; Other students may apply for credit exemption or remedial before enrollment.
2. Credit recognition is considered to be passed if the course titles are the same, and the rest are authorized to be reviewed by the course instructor of the year.
3. Exceptions must be approved by the department chairman.
4. Credit exemption for prerequisite courses must be claimed within the first academic year.

* * Elective Courses (24 credits) Requirements

- The courses offered by the department are started by 753XXX/ 761XXX.
- Elective courses offered by other departments can be recognized for a maximum of 9 credits for students in the division of Information Science and Engineering and the division of Intelligent Computing. A maximum of 12 credits can be recognized for cross-divisional students in the Information Science and Engineering division.

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* * Seminar Passing Standards

1. The attendance record is required, and those who fail to sign in will be regarded as absent.
2. Speeches held by the department are not allowed to be absent.
3. Attend at least 7 lectures by external speakers. Proxy signature is strictly prohibited.
4. Students who are late for class, leave early, or leave during class for more than 30 minutes will be considered absent.
5. **Complete personal research progress once.**
6. Fulfillment of 1-5 rules will be considered a passing grade.
7. Master students in the department of Computer Science must pass two courses of Seminar(I)~(VI) in order to graduate.
